**STUDENT USE OF
AUTOMOBILE
USED ON CAMPUS**

The high school campus shall require that a student who drives an automobile onto a campus have proof of the following:

- Valid Driver's License
- Auto Insurance for all cars regardless of its state of registration

The campus shall issue a parking permit that indicates that the above requirements have been met.

If a student drives/and or parks an automobile without the proper documents listed above, the campus administration may have the car towed at the student's expense and/or may call the proper legal authorities.

A student who violates the set campus speed limit, uses his automobile as a weapon or to threaten others, is involved in a automobile accident on school grounds, or remains in the automobile after parking, shall be prohibited from driving the automobile onto the campus for a period of time to be determined by the campus administration.
