

**NOTICE OF ELECTION**

STATE OF TEXAS §

TO ALL THE DULY QUALIFIED, RESIDENT ELECTORS OF CENTER POINT INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election will be held within and throughout the CENTER POINT INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT on May 8, 2010, pursuant to and in accordance with the following excerpts from the Order Calling School Building Bond Election passed and approved by the Board of Trustees of the Center Point Independent School District on March 3, 2010;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF CENTER POINT INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. Call of Election; Date; Eligible Electors; and Hours. An election (the “Election”) shall be held on Saturday, May 8, 2010, which is sixty-two (62) or more days from the date of the adoption of this order, within and throughout the territory of the District at which all resident, qualified electors of the District shall be entitled to vote. The Board hereby finds that holding the Election on such date is in the public interest. The hours during which the polling places are to be open at the Election shall be from 7:00 o’clock a.m. to 7:00 o’clock p.m.

Section 2. Voting Precincts; Polling Places; and Election Officers. Except as otherwise provided herein, the voting precincts for the Election and the polling places for the voting precincts are hereby established as identified on Exhibit A hereto. The Board will appoint the persons to serve as the precinct judges and alternate judges for each voting precinct for the Election at a subsequent meeting of the Board of Trustees.

In the event that the Superintendent shall determine, from time to time, that (a) one or more of the polling places hereby established and designated shall become unavailable or unsuitable for such use, or it would be in the District’s best interests to relocate one or more polling places, or (b) a precinct judge or alternate judge hereby appointed or hereinafter designated shall become unqualified or unavailable, the Superintendent is hereby authorized to designate and appoint in writing substitute polling places, precinct judges or alternate judges, giving such notice as is required by the Election Code and as deemed sufficient by the Superintendent.

Section 3. Proposition. At the Election there shall be submitted to the resident, qualified electors of the District the following proposition (the “Proposition”):

PROPOSITION

SHALL THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES (THE "BOARD") OF THE CENTER POINT INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT (THE "DISTRICT") BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE BONDS OF THE DISTRICT, IN ONE OR MORE SERIES OR INSTALLMENTS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,990,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, ACQUISITION AND EQUIPMENT OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN THE DISTRICT (INCLUDING THE REHABILITATION, RENOVATION, EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENT THEREOF), WHICH BONDS SHALL MATURE, BEAR INTEREST AND BE ISSUED AND SOLD IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE; AND SHALL THE BOARD BE AUTHORIZED TO LEVY AND PLEDGE, AND CAUSE TO BE ASSESSED AND COLLECTED, ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAXES ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT SUFFICIENT, WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO RATE OR AMOUNT, TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS AS THEY BECOME DUE, ALL AS AUTHORIZED BY THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, INCLUDING PARTICULARLY (BUT NOT BY WAY OF LIMITATION) SUBCHAPTER A OF CHAPTER 45, TEXAS EDUCATION CODE, TOGETHER WITH ALL AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONS THERETO, AND OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA?

Section 4.     Ballots. The ballots shall conform to the requirements of the Election Code and shall have written or printed thereon the following:

OFFICIAL BALLOT

PROPOSITION

THE ISSUANCE OF \$9,990,000 SCHOOL BUILDING BONDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, ACQUISITION AND EQUIPMENT OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN THE DISTRICT (INCLUDING THE REHABILITATION, RENOVATION, EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENT THEREOF), AND THE LEVYING OF THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF

Section 5.     Voting. Voting in the Election, including early voting by personal appearance, shall be by electronic or paper ballot. Each voter desiring to vote in favor of a Proposition shall mark the ballot indicating "FOR" such Proposition, and each voter desiring to vote against a Proposition shall mark the ballot indicating "AGAINST" the Proposition. Voting shall be in accordance with the Election Code.

Section 6. Early Voting. Early voting, both by personal appearance and by mail, shall be conducted in accordance with the Election Code. Early voting shall be conducted at the main early voting polling place between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. from April 26, 2010 through May 4, 2010, except Saturdays, Sundays and state holidays. The Board hereby establishes the Practice Gymnasium located at 217 China Street, Center Point, Texas 78010 as the place within the boundaries of the District at which early voting shall be conducted.

In addition to early voting at the main early voting polling place, early voting shall be conducted at the temporary branch polling places on the dates and at the times as described in Exhibit B hereto.

The Board hereby appoints Joe Armistead as the early voting clerk. The mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail may be sent is as follows: Nadene Alford, Kerr County Election Coordinator, 700 Main Street, Suite #124, Kerrville, Texas 78028.

The early voting clerk shall keep the offices open for early voting during the hours described above. For the use of those voters who are entitled by law to vote early by mail, the early voting clerk shall provide each voter with a ballot with instructions to mark the ballot indicating his or her vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the Proposition.

The Board hereby appoints Eva Washburn as the presiding judge of the special early voting ballot board to count and return early voting ballots in accordance with the Election Code. The presiding judge shall appoint at least two (2) other members to the early voting ballot board to perform the duties set forth for such board in the Election Code.
