

STUDENT CONDUCT
TELECOMMUNICATION DEVICES

FNCE (R)

ACTIVATION AND POSSESSION	<p>Students are prohibited from possessing an activated telecommunication or any other electronic device during the instructional day, which is from beginning bell to the ending bell of the school day. These devices may not be visible or displayed by the student.</p> <p>To eliminate texting or hidden use of the device, teacher's may require that the inactivated cellular phone on the top of the students work area.</p>
VIOLATION	<p>They may possess and use a telecommunication or other device after school hours and at athletic activities.</p> <p>All violations shall be reported to the appropriate administrator. The administrator will confiscate the device and within two days will notify the parent that the device is in the possession of the school.</p>
RETRIEVAL BY PARENT	<p>The parent has 30 calendar days from the day of confiscation to retrieve the device and pay a fee of \$15.00 to the District. Devices not claimed within 30 days will be destroyed.</p>
OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES	<p>Other electronic devices include i-pods, MP3's, CD players, radios, DVD players, PSP's, gameboys, or other devices that are deemed to interfere with the instructional program.</p>
